

Provisions supplied by Montreat College for each scholarship-based clay target competitor:

- Membership to the Biltmore Sporting Clays Club.
- 1000 rounds of 12 ga. Practice ammunition each semester.
- 500 rounds of 12 ga. Competition ammunition each semester.
- 1000 targets each semester at Biltmore Sporting Clays Club.
- Shooters can purchase additional targets at Biltmore Sporting Clays Club at \$.12 each/1000 (\$120 plus taxes)
- Shooters can purchase additional ammunition at the Sportsman's Warehouse at \$5.20/box if purchasing at least 4 flats (i.e., 1000 rounds) when notifying management that the shooter is on the Montreat College clay target team.
- Travel expenses (i.e., transportation, food and lodging).
- Tournament fees.
- Safe storage for all shotguns, ammo and sundry supplies.
- Weekly training from Coach Powell and assistant(s).
- Scholarship funding from Montreat College.
- Prayer support and encouragement from the coaches.

Expectations of shooters:

- Attending practices as academic demands (i.e., classes) allow.
- Timely practice attendance.
- Disciplining the mind so that it is an asset rather than a liability (Each shooter was made in His Image and for His Purpose, for prospering and not for failure)
- Timely class attendance.
- Solid academic performance (cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher).
- Observing and honoring the behavior standards/codes of Montreat College.
- Practicing safety in every respect (shotgun handling in the safe, during transportation from the safe to practice/competition – always empty and broken down, adherence to Biltmore-mandated safety practices and the safety practices as mandated by our competition-hosting ranges).
- Participation in fund-raising endeavors.
- Community service projects at least 1 time each semester.
- Miscellaneous other responsibilities as the student-athlete lifestyle in this space becomes more obvious.
