

ACUI & SCTP 2022–23 Season Updates – September

ACUI & SCTP are committed to providing great shooting opportunities for all student athletes! We are excited that more teams are starting up at institutions around the country. Students come first in our program, as they always have and always will.

2022–23 Season Pricing

Teams are already starting to register for the fall events! Our member pricing for the season is as follows:

- American Skeet/American Trap (100 Targets): \$55
- Doubles American Skeet/Doubles American Trap (50 Targets): \$30
- Sporting Clays (100 Targets): \$65
- Super Sporting (50 Targets): \$50
- International Skeet/Internationals Trap: \$80

This price also includes a lunch on Saturdays for all athletes and coaches.

Ammunition will not be provided through ACUI; we're working with many ranges to ensure there is a supply on site for purchase if needed.

Scholarship and Matching Programs for the Season

ACUI and SCPT are offering scholarship opportunities. At each event, 10 \$500 scholarships will be awarded to those who receive HOA and winners of random prize drawings. Tournaments with over 200 attendees may also include random door prizes.

There will also be MidwayUSA matching opportunities to continue to support our student athletes and teams.

College Day in July

Each year, SCTP runs its National Team Championship event starting the second Saturday in July at the Cardinal Center in Marengo, Ohio. During that time, the last Friday of that tournament is College Day! Hundreds of students and parents come to meet potential college. Colleges registered with SCTP/ACUI and attending at least one of the tournaments (bowl series or national championships in March) are welcome to attend and talk with potential team candidates!

SCTP's Shot System, Insurance, and More

Through the partnership between ACUI and SCTP, we will now use SCTP's SHOT system for all registration, squadding, and scoring-this consolidates the previous process into one system and allows teams to squad when initially registering. This will also allow quicker access to live results.

ACUI is covering all participating team's SCTP membership fees for access to the system; should you wish to host your own local event, you can run it through SCTP's SHOT system at no charge.

Additionally, with this partnership, all teams/institutions are covered by SCTP's \$10 million liability insurance policy as well! This policy will cover your shooting range and your school by filling out the third-party form, available on the SCPT website.

High School Participation This Season

The following events will have components of competition that will be open to high schoolers to encourage networking and relationship building with collegiate teams:

- Upper Midwest Conference Championships Marengo, Ohio
- Central Midwest Conference Championships Sparta, Illinois
- West Coast (Fall) Conference Championships Colorado Springs, Colorado (based on availability)
- Lower Midwest Conference Championships San Antonio
- Lower West Coast Conference Championships Savannah, Georgia (based on availability)

ACUI Policy Updates

The following updates were made for this season:

- We are no longer requiring that new schools be placed in D4 for the nationals tournament. Rather they will be placed the same as all other teams (according to the number of students they have competing).
- Students no longer must shoot all disciplines for their scores to count toward an HOA award.
- Classifications for nationals will now return to a Class A, B, C, and Open system based on scores gathered at ACUI & SCTP events throughout the season. We still do not require that teams compete in our bowl series events to attend Nationals.
