

Junior Olympic Trap & Skeet Incentive

Application Guide

USA Shooting, Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP), and MidwayUSA Foundation are supporting the expansion of **Junior Olympic Trap and Skeet matches into new states**. This incentive is offered **exclusively to State Junior Olympic host venues in states that currently do not offer a competition**.

Who Is Eligible

An organization **must meet ALL the following requirements**:

- ✓ Be an **active SCTP program in good standing**
- ✓ Be a **new State Junior Olympic host venue** located in a **state that does NOT currently host** a Junior Olympic Trap or Skeet match
- ✓ Have an **active Team Endowment with MidwayUSA Foundation**
- ✓ Host a **USA Shooting sanctioned Junior Olympic Trap or Skeet match**

Multiple Incentives

USA Shooting

- For this Junior Olympic Match, the host club will be provided a complimentary club membership for the year. In addition, the coach or administrator who will manage the club account will also be provided a complimentary membership.
- Will accept score submission through the SHOT System for all SCTP members.

Automatic Raffle Entry

- All eligible clubs that host a qualifying match are **automatically entered**
- Winners are selected **at random**
- **Raffle opportunities include:**

SCTP:

- Breeser Omni-2 Red Dot
- Big Frig 45-Quart Cooler
- (3) Big Frig SCTP 20oz Tumblers
- (3) SCTP Gun Socks

MidwayUSA Foundation:

- Endowment dollars to benefit the MidwayUSA Foundation Team Endowment of their choice.
 - 1st Club: **\$1,000**
 - 2nd Club: **\$500**

(Awards are endowment donations only — no cash or products.)

Timeline

- **Application Deadline:** Extended for qualified hosts to April 1, 2026
- **Event Deadline:** All State Junior Olympic events must be completed by June 24, 2026
- **Incentive Period:** February 1 – June 24, 2026
- A list of all qualifying clubs will be publicly posted for transparency
- **Raffle Drawings:** Conducted by SCTP
- **Winners Announced:** By July 10, 2026

Step-by-Step: How to Participate

Step 1: Confirm eligibility

- Active Team Endowment with MidwayUSA Foundation
- Active SCTP program in good standing
- State does not currently host a JO Trap or Skeet match

Step 2: Schedule and apply for a USA Shooting sanctioned Junior Olympic Trap or Skeet match (*Skeet field or wobble trap field required*)

Step 3: Host the match during the incentive period

Step 4: Eligible clubs will be entered into the raffles automatically (See incentive above)

Quick Answers to Common Questions

Do we need a Team Endowment?

Yes. An active MidwayUSA Foundation Team Endowment is required. A list of endowments can be found at <https://www.midwayusafoundation.org/find-team-fund-team/>.

Do we need to apply separately for the raffles?

No. Hosting an eligible match automatically enters your club.

Are product prizes and endowment dollars separate?

Yes. USA Shooting/SCTP provide host support and product awards. MidwayUSA Foundation provides endowment dollars.

Can current Junior Olympic host states apply?

No. This incentive is only for new State Junior Olympic host venues.

Final Note

If your organization meets the eligibility requirements and follows the steps above, **no additional confirmation is needed.**
